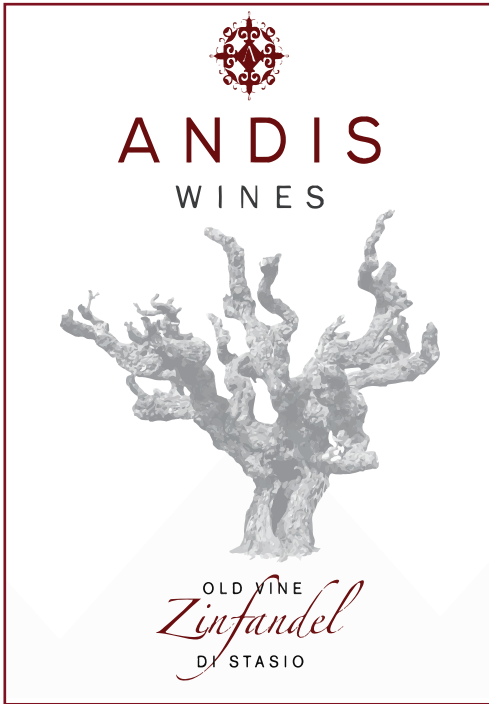

Vineyard Notes

Planted in 1950, Di Stasio Vineyard is an old vine Zinfandel vineyard that Andis Wines is proud to be working with. What makes this vineyard a true icon of the California Shenandoah Valley AVA in Amador County are its unique soils ranging from decomposed granite to sandy loam, its dry farming head-trained method, that leads to low yields.

Winemaker Notes

2017 Di Stasio Zinfandel marks our first vintage from this vineyard. In the nose the wine has an extracted tea leaf flavor, spicy and strawberry jam on the palate. This vintage range from a cooler climate style in the nose to warmer climate style wines in the finish.
