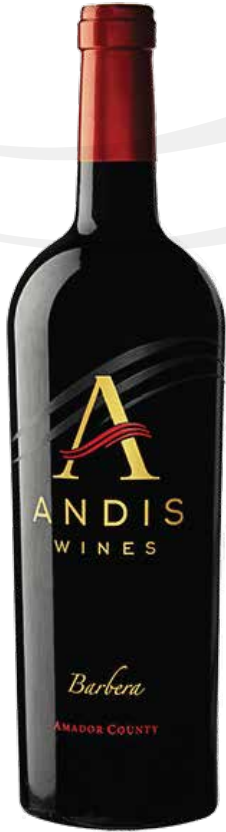

WINEMAKER NOTES

Barbera is the classic Amador grape that's simply delicious vintage after vintage and the easiest wine choice you will make all week. No other varietal captures the beauty of the Sierra Foothills.

Round and fruit forward, this vintage exhibits aromas of raspberries and cedar, a robust palate balancing dark fruit with a dash of black tea, and a bright finish. The perennial crowd pleaser, it pairs with virtually anything. Try with pizza, roast beef, or simply on its own.

"Elegant in texture and concentrated in flavor, this medium-bodied wine has fresh blackberry and blueberry aromas paired with ripe fruit flavors and an easygoing texture without a lot of tannin. Black pepper and cardamom whiffs add some complexity." -- WINE ENTHUSIAST
